I became VP Operations in January. I would like to thank Steve Knoxx, my predecessor, for all the work he put in to keep this theatre going.

In 2021/2022, Theatre Aurora:

- Finished work on the amazing dressing room and crossover update.
- Had a clean-up day, had a deep-clean in our building, and now has the theatre cleaned by a professional cleaning company twice a month.
- Bought a new sea can container and were able to clean out the basement room under the stage.
- Was given a donated garbage bin for disposal of large items.
- Painted and refreshed FOH area and washrooms.
- Had a full Fire Inspection and have made much-needed repairs and updates to our building making it safer and in compliance with fire regulations and insurance.
- Replaced lighting in our lobby as needed.
- Worked with the Town of Aurora to guarantee a lease until 2031.
- Had our front gardens professionally landscaped.
- Will be renewing our lobby in August/September, including installing a new accessible washroom, updating our accessible spaces in the theatre, and installing a new floor, all thanks to a grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation.

We continue to monitor the building for needed repairs and updates.
